

## **LEATHER CARE**

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### **NORMAL MAINTENANCE**

Under normal use, regular dusting and vacuum cleaning is all that is necessary.

### **SPOTS AND SPILLS**

Wipe excess liquid immediately with a clean absorbent cloth or sponge. If necessary, use clean luke-warm water only and let air dry.

If water is used, clean the entire area where the spot occurred. An example would be the entire seat or the entire arm. Do not dry the wet area with hair dryers, etc.

### **STUBBORN SPOTS AND STAINS**

Use a mild non-detergent soap solution (Ivory or Neutrogena). Apply the soap to a clean wet sponge and wash, then rinse thoroughly. Let air dry naturally.

### **BUTTER, OIL AND GREASE**

Wipe excess butter, oil or grease off the leather with a clean dry cloth, and then leave it alone, as the spot will dissipate into the leather in a short period of time. Do not apply water or try to wash butter, oil or grease spot.

### **DO NOT USE**

Cleaning solvent, furniture polish, oils, varnish, abrasive cleaners, saddle soap or ammonia water.

### **IMPORTANT**

These are the recommended or suggested methods of cleaning, but Paul Brayton Designs is not responsible for damage incurred while cleaning. Always test the cleaning method on a hidden area of the furniture piece. NEVER use a cleaning solvent. For serious damage or stains contact a professional leather cleaner.
